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HIGH-EFFICIENCY TOILET AND URINAL REBATE PROGRAM

The rebate amount of up to \$100 is being offered for every residential or commercial 3.0 gallon per flush or larger toilet replaced with a 1.28 gallon per flush (GPF) or less, High-Efficiency Toilet or any EPA WaterSense approved Toilet. (See https://www.epa.gov/watersense/product-search)

The rebate amount of up to \$100 is being offered for every commercial urinal that is replaced with a Waterless Urinal or EPA WaterSense approved Flushing Urinal.

Rebate Eligibility Requirements:

1. You must be a treated water customer of PCWA. The toilets/urinals must be installed at the service address listed on the application.

WaterSense

- 2. New toilets purchased must be rated 1.28 (GPF) or better.
- 3. Old toilets replaced must be rated at 3.0 (GPF) or more. (Most qualifying models were installed in homes built prior to 1994) Rebates are not available for the replacement of an existing 1.6 (GPF) Ultra Low Flow Toilet.
- 4. New construction is not eligible for rebate under this program.
- 5. Total rebate amount will not exceed the amount paid for the toilet/urinal. Rebate does <u>not</u> include installation costs.

Here is a guideline to help determine if your toilet(s) use 3.0 or more GPT:

Year Toilet was	Gallons Per Flush
manufactured:	(GPF)
Pre-1982	5-7
1982-1993	3.5
1994-Present	1.6 or Better

Year Urinal was	Gallons Per Flush
manufactured:	(GPF)
Pre-1992	3

You can locate the manufacture date under the lid of most toilets. A Water Efficiency Specialist can help you determine the flush volume if you are still not sure of the age or size of your existing toilet(s).

Follow these steps to receive a rebate: (Online or by Mail)

Online:

- 1. Purchase and install product(s) within 60 days of the receipt of the application.
- 2. Complete, e-Sign and submit the online application form. The rebate will not be processed without the sales receipt or installation invoice.

By Mail:

- 1. Purchase and install product(s) within 60 days of the receipt of the application.
- 2. Complete and sign the application form.
- 3. Attach a copy of a dated sales receipt or installation invoice from a licensed contractor. If you want to retain your original receipt, please make sure to send in a copy as originals will not be returned. The rebate will not be processed without the sales receipt or installation invoice.
